

# MACS TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

## ALL ATHLETIC EVENTS

Up-Dated February 25, 2010

### I. ADMISSION FEES

- A. All rounds
  - 1. Adults: \$4.00
  - 2. Students: (grades 1–12): \$3.00
    - 3. K-5 and below = Free
  - 4. Family rate: \$12.00
  - 5. Church and School Staff with identification: \$2.00

### II. Team member admission fees.

- A. Team members and cheerleaders are admitted free of charge.
- B. Each team is allowed a maximum of 3 assistants (scorekeeper, statistician, assistant coach, etc.)
- C. The bus driver for the team is admitted free.

### III. Each winning team and/or host must call in the results of their game the night of the game. The numbers are listed in order of preference.

### IV. The host school is to:

- A. Provide officials. (See handbook XII)
- B. Provide game balls.
- C. Collect admission
- D. Pay the officials
- E. Fill out the tournament game report (TGR).
- F. Send the TGR to MACS Athletics: ASAP

### V. MACS Athletics will, after receiving the required information:

- A. Send due compensation to the host school for officials

- B. Send due compensation only when admission is taken.

VI. The team assigned as the home team:

- A. Is to wear a light colored jersey.
- B. Is to confirm with the other team

VII. Individual Sports

- A. Soccer—each team should supply a ball “boy”.
- B. Volleyball--each team is to provide a qualified line judge.
- C. Basketball--each team is to have a scorekeeper, home team will have the official book

VIII. Each team should call their opponent prior to the game to verify uniform colors, time, location, etc.

IX. When a team is late, you must wait 15 minutes before declaring a forfeit; however, if a team has called the school to notify you of tardiness due to an act of God, extra time may be permitted as you await their arrival.

X. Forfeit

- A. Any school failing to play their scheduled game:
  - 1. Will be fined \$50.00
  - 2. Will not be allowed to compete in any MACS tournament until the fine is

paid.

XI. Officials

- A. MHSAA registered officials only are to be used.
- B. Officials are not to be connected with any school or church which has a team competing in that division.
- C. If only one official shows up for a game, you may:
  - 1. Start playing immediately and not wait for the second official,
  - 2. Waiting 15 minutes for a second official. If no official appears at that point,

play will begin.

D. If no official shows up for a game, the game will be postponed to the next playable date as determined by the two schools with MACS Athletic Commissioner’s approval. This is for the purpose of expediency and to keep the tournament on schedule.
