Dear MACS Athletic Directors,

We are very excited to invite your school to the first annual MACS 3v3 State Basketball Tournament. The tournament will be held on Saturday, March 6 2010, and hosted by Wixom Christian School. Any MACS school that is not entering a team in the 5v5 MACS tournament may enter up to two teams (boys and girls) in the 3v3 tournament. Trophies will be awarded to the top two teams (2 girls' finalists and 2 boys' finalists). The following rules are included to help schools determine if they are interested in participating. A complete list of rules is available on the MACS web-site or by email request.

General Tournament Rules

Team is limited to 3-4 players

Each possession begins at the top of the key with one pass in – games are half-court
Scoring is by ones for a regular 2-point basket and twos for a 3-point field goal
Every change of possession must be cleared to the 3-point line

Game is over when one team reaches 11 points or at 15 minutes (running clock)

Player fouled in the act of shooting and misses the basket retains possession of the ball

Player fouled in the act of shooting and makes the basket, basket counts and team keeps possession

One time-out per team per game is allowed

In case of a tie, there will be a two-minute overtime, alternating possession gets ball
