

JUDGES:

In order to have three judges in each competition, we are asking your school's tournament supervisor to submit the names of qualified members of your faculty who would be willing and able to spend the day judging. **We need the judges to not have any other obligations during the day.** When three judges are not available for an event each student will receive evaluations from two judges.

PHOTOCOPIED MUSIC: The state competition will follow the 2005 Senior High State Competition Manual on photocopied music.

COPYRIGHT: Please note that illegal use of copyrighted material will be disqualified. Written permission from publishers must be submitted at the time of performance for verification.

PARKING: If arriving by bus, please use the drop off area in front of the church steps in the Perrine Road parking lot.

DRESS CODE: The State competition will follow the dress code as explained in the 2005 Senior High State Competition Manual.

JUDGING FORMS: Students competing in a category requiring judging forms must submit two complete judging forms at the time of their competition. Judging forms are located in the back of the 2005 Senior High State Competition Manual. They will also be available at the MACS Information Desk for \$1.00 per sheet.

ACCOMPANIST: Accompanist may only accompany six times. Accompanist may not be a judge or music director that has other obligations.

STUDENT ACCOMPANISTS: They may accompany up to six group events and only 3 individual events. **The maximum number of accompanying is six events.**

JUNIOR HIGH: In the Sr. High Competition students in grades 7, 8, and 9 may compete in the orchestra/band and handbell choir. Students in grade 9 may also compete in the categories of debate, ensembles, choral groups, choir, and Bible quizzing.

January 14—SCHOOL REGISTRATION FORM

All forms must be postmarked by Thursday, January 14. (Packet must include check and forms to be considered complete.) An Individual Competition Entry Form has been included in your 2005 Senior High State Competition Manual for your use; however, you do not need to include this form with your registration.

JANUARY 14, 2010—REGISTERING ON THE WEB

Your school will need to be registered by January 14 by using the internet. Details will be available at a later time.

February 19—CANCELED CATEGORIES

Categories will be cancelled if we have one or less individual/group in the category. There must be at least two schools participating to keep the category for competition. You will be notified by February 6, if we need to cancel a category because lack of interest.

April 16—SPELLING

The Junior and Senior High Spelling Bee is Friday, April 16. Registration materials will come in the mail from Community Baptist School. **DO NOT PAY CALVARY BAPTIST FOR SPELLING CONTESTANTS.**

March 16—BIBLE QUIZZING

Maranatha in Clarkston will be hosting Bible Quizzing. The Junior High and Senior High will quiz on the same day. Materials will come in the mail. **DO NOT PAY CALVARY BAPTIST FOR BIBLE QUIZ TEAMS.**
